Or maybe you're interested in UX/UI and want to create visual content that lives on screens, then you'd take Web and photo classes. Whatever you choose, it will be important that you do your industry research, ask your professors a ton of questions, and talk to professionals to understand the skills needed to do the job you're interested in. Then just choose your classes accordingly.

Choose three (3) strategy and four (4) skills courses. After choosing your strategy and skills mix, you'll be ready to test yourself with the final (6) studio courses. This is the final step toward getting you on the path to a creative career.
